Care Plus welfare Organisation have started the mission with its immortal intention. The people who were part of this Organisation have continued their struggle to accomplish their goals even in presence of all the problems and difficulties.

Care Plus Welfare Organisation, with the help of its resources and donors have commenced serving to the less fortunate people in the health area so that these people would have reasonable and modern facilities to change their lives positively. Environmental pollution, hunger and not knowing the basic hygienic principles are the main reasons due to which people likely to become the patients of deadly diseases like Diabetics and Hepatitis. That's why Care Plus welfare Organisation have decided to serve in the field of health and establish special counters in different hospitals and health centers and start the mission to use the resources provided by the government in a better way. For the same purpose Care Plus welfare Organisation have decided to establish a huge and fully facilitated hospital in Multan. After acquiring the place, the construction has been started and hopefully it will be completed timely.

BASIC OBJECTIVES AND GOALS

1. To promote the formal and informal education and to work in urban and rural areas to progress in social work.
2. To take care of the basic rights of under privileged women and to take practical steps towards the betterment of their socio-economic status so they can spend their life with dignity.
3. To run the campaign about protection of basic human rights of women effectively, and to prepare the voice and promotional material, organize workshops, debates, seminars.
4. To make people skillful and to act on the programs of provision of resources for this purpose.
5. To provide the basic facilities to mother and child health and to take all necessary precautionary measures to control the mortality rate and provision of basic facilities for effected classes to overcome this sad scenario.
6. To discourage the lawlessness, violence, extremism and other negative trends and to organize the awareness campaign to spread the message of peace and

brotherhood and to tell people that how important it is. Organize mental training to eradicate the violence and injustice and to make this campaign effective.

7. To launch campaigns regarding the general health of people and to commence the programs related to basic health facilities and to act upon them with full honesty.

INCREASE IN LITERACY RATE


8. To assist in the efforts to increase the literacy rate of backward and less progressive areas and to make efforts of government successful by eradicating the darkness of ignorance. And to promote the formal and informal education by the help of our own resources and charitable persons.
9. Protection of basic human rights and to spread awareness about fundamental rights and its importance especially for backward and uneducated people.
10. Women are half of our population so make them to participate fully in the nation building tasks and to work for the salvation from the problems arose due to gender discrimination. These are the goals which need some serious dedication and efforts. For this need Organisation has made an effective plan on which the work has been started with full sincerity. To expand this project and to make women an active part of society.

HOSPITAL FOR HEPATITIS WITH MODERN FACILITIES IN MULTAN

11. To establish the hospitals designed with modern medical facilities just like the hospital in Multan for Hepatitis C and to establish the centers for this fatal and deadly disease of Diabetes to diagnose and treat this dangerous disease. It is our basic goal to treat and diagnose the needy people because population's major part is suffering from this disease but they don't know it.
12. We cannot attain real progress and prosperity without the establishment of strong democratic society. So our Organisation have started a particular campaign to highlight the importance and utility of democracy. In this regard it is to make sure to conduct debates, seminars, educational and insightful functions and the participation of thinkers and political leaders having democratic thoughts. Organisation has held many successful functions for this cause and it is expected to expand these type of gatherings and functions in future.

RIGHT USE OF VOTE

13. The sanctity and the right use of the vote is a key to the durability of democracy. In a society where people are divided in class system and along with the low literacy rate people have very less political and democratic thinking, there it becomes inevitable to educate the people about the importance of vote. People who don't know the right use of vote cannot take the right decision due to which it become impossible to choose the able and talented candidates. Here it is common to talk about the right



use of vote but practically no step has taken. Few semi government Organisations are working on this but it is insufficient. Our Organisation have started the awareness campaign keeping in view the sanctity and importance of vote and continued educating people about the right use of vote to the people. Prior to the general election of 2013 and later for municipal election, Organisation had organized training workshops for the right use of vote, especially focused on the women voters awareness and training. In this way people will be educated for free and fair election.

CHILD LABOUR AND VIOLENCE ON WOMEN

14. It is very common trend of child labor and violence on women and it is equal to the violation of basic human rights and social injustice and oppression. It is the need of time to get rid of these trends. Organisation has started various practical plans for children of school going age so that they become a productive citizen of country. Women are targeted for violence due to the gender discrimination and illiteracy. A healthy society can be formed by prevention of this shameful act. Organisation has started working on the prevention of violence on women very earlier and now expansion to this project is in progress. By increasing literacy rate and educating girls would help to decrease this trend. Literate mothers would train their children in a healthy manner and they'll become individuals with positive thinking. They'll consider this act of violence on women as inappropriate and will avoid doing it by their selves. Organisation has organized discussion gatherings for awareness for this. It will be continuing in future too.
15. In our country, alarming number of people are bound to spend their life under the line of poverty. This number needs to get lower and end. And this could be possible only when solid planning towards the justified division of resources will occur. For this a survey in these backward areas on reality grounds is needed. Organisation have decided to do survey for such neglected areas in the basic fields of education and health so that the reality can be prevailed and to share this survey with relevant government departments. For this purpose, government will assemble a team of experienced individuals. We are lacking in planning and numbers are just in papers. The only paper work cannot solve these problems.



SERVING POOR AND NEGLECTED PEOPLE

16. Care Plus Welfare Organisation is an active reforming and welfare institution and its only aim is to serve poor people and to assist them to access the basic facilities and to aware them about the constructive path. Organisation has progressed towards its basic goal in a short time after its establishment. The fundamental aim of Organisation is to strive to eradicate this class system and the unjustified distribution of resources among classes and Organisation is quite passionate to succeed in this public service.

HOLDING FREE CAMPS

17. Care Plus Welfare Organisation Pakistan have held free medical, eye, diabetics and hepatitis camps in the areas where the facility of medical is not available or not of good quality and this medical camp series is continued since last five years. The patients of diabetics and hepatitis get free facilities even.



THE PLAN OF ESTABLISHING BURN UNITS IN BACKWARD AREAS

18. It is necessary to establish the burn units and hospitals in neglected areas to treat the affected people in result of any fire incident or accident. To address this issue Organisation has made a plan to establish burn units and hospitals in underprivileged areas of the country. Surveys and reports are under development to work on it gradually.
19. Care Plus Welfare Organisation Pakistan is a welfare association which is working for serving public and humanity. It feels quite good that the head of the Organisation Mr. Zahid Mehmood Basra and the members and volunteers of his team are working with sincerity because they all have the passion to serve poor people unconditionally and they will continue to progress towards their goals.
20. It is a request to the people who have kind heart to join the mission of Care Plus Welfare Organisation to make this common struggle successful. This is a public welfare movement to which every sensible person should contribute to achieve these goals.

OUR SERVICES IN THE FIELD OF EDUCATION AND UPCOMING

PROVISION OF BASIC FACILITIES IN BACKWARD AREAS

Population of the country is increasing with the passage of time but the situation regarding resources and basic facilities is not satisfactory. The numbers of census of 2017 shows that the country's population has increased more than 7crores since 1998. In 1998, population was more than 13crore and 23lacs that has been increased more than 20crore and 77lacs. To the relevance in which population is increasing, the provision of resources has not increased in the same manner so a big part of the population is still quite far from basic facilities. Basic facilities are mainly health and education. In these fields, facilities are not in a condition which can be declared as satisfactory or in a good condition for a lay man. The condition of health and treatment in far flung rural areas are quite disappointing. Hospitals are not in the reach to the inhabitants of these areas and it becomes really difficult for patients to access hospitals of city because link roads are not there. Timely treatment facility is not available so deaths are normal. People are unaware of health issues and they are not educated about the precautionary measures for health. Proper arrangements of hygiene are not there. Clean drinking water is not available. Lack of water drainage facility is present. Under these circumstances epidemic diseases get spread and it is quite impossible to take appropriate steps. Due to the difficulties of passages government help reach to the affected areas with delay.

In the season of rain and flood the situation becomes more horrific, people not only face homelessness but also epidemic diseases. It is normal for people to face a lot of difficulties for treatment and medical facilities. Cities have government and private hospitals having modern medical facilities. Though rural areas also have health centers but they cannot provide medical facilities according to the population because these centers have limited number of staff and resources. Education sector have the same situation. The number of government educational institutions are so less. If few schools are set up in the far flung areas, then they are not in proper operational condition because of the non-availability of staff. People cannot educate their children even if they wish to because schools are situated so far from their homes and they have not strength to send their children that far. Educational institutions are present in cities but it is impossible for rural population to reach there. People living in cities have limited resources could not provide their children with education because of inflation. Major part of our population has been failed due to the class system in our country.

Organisations have done some remarkable work. To continue these services in education and health our association “Care Plus Welfare Organisation” has been formed and have done some noticeable work for humanity that got appreciation from different Organisation by the grace of Allah.

PAKISTAN’S EDUCATION SYSTEM AND GRADES

If we analyze the education system of Pakistan, then some changes have brought in it. In constitution, education have handed over to the provinces so that the facilities of education can be provided according to the needs in a better way on provincial level.

The education in country is provided in six levels:

PRIMARY EDUCATION

There are two standards for primary education in the country, one is general schools and second are under English primary education system, in which play group, nursery and prep classes, while in other schools grade 1 to 5 has been taught. It is a sad situation that the proper attention has not paid to the education sector.

ABOUT PRIMARY EDUCATION

Care Plus Welfare Organisation have chose two major areas in which education is included. It is in our plan to expand the facilities of primary education in different government schools. The survey has begun regarding this and preparation of list of schools are under process which are facing problems. We are trying to our fullest to assist in building boundary walls, class rooms and wash rooms and to provide electricity, Provision of uniform, books and copies are also an important part of the plan.



ROLE IN PROMOTION OF MIDDLE LEVEL EDUCATION

The number for middle level schools are not that much in backward areas but as compare to past number of middle level schools have increased but they are not enough according to the proportion of the population. In the middle schools for girls same problems are present which are existing in primary and high schools. Boundary wall of the school is a problem which is on the top of the list.

SECONDARY EDUCATION

Matriculation and intermediate are the 3rd and 4th level of our education system and are very less in numbers in far flung areas. The standard of education is getting low. The Academy culture is propagating. It is the need of time to make reforms in country's education system. Our Organisation is not in the position to make these reforms, however, it is our intention to raise the voice of public in government Organisations, especially for the education of girls. Care Plus Welfare Organisation is already working for provision of uniform, pens, copies and books and have done a prominent service related to formal and non-formal education and we are also planning for its expansion.

UNIVERSITY EDUCATION

With the passage of time it is becoming difficult to get graduation and masters level education. The heavy fee structure of universities are the barriers in getting education for poor students. It is our national need to make university level education feasible. Likewise, effective planning should be done in the fields of medical, engineering and law for higher education.

Care Plus welfare Organisation will organize dialogue on getting education and the system of education on university level between experts of education and develop reports of these dialogues. After developing these reports they'll be send to the planners of education field to make education facilities accessible for all.

WOMEN'S EDUCATION AND THE ROLE OF CARE PLUS WELFARE ORGANISATION

Women are half of our total population. Their education is so much vital and it needs special attention and planning.

According to the census of 2017:





ROLE OF CARE PLUS WELFARE ORGANISATION ABOUT PROTECTION OF WOMEN RIGHTS AND VIOLENCE AGAINST WOMEN AND DISCRIMINATIVE BEHAVIOUR

Women are of half of the country's population and constitution & law and our religion Islam gave them the equal rights. Their social, economic and legal status is as equal to men. Islam is the only religion in the world who gave the right and deserving place to the women but practically, in our society people don't care about the rights of women. Kidnapping, murder, sexual harassment, acid attacks and deprivation from family property and likewise other issues are there which are consuming our values like termites. It is totally against our great values of ethics, law and religious slogans. It becomes our common practice to violate the basic human right in which women rights are on the top. It is need of the time to address this issue because without the safety of women a healthy and progressive society cannot be created. In the light of all this situation our Organisation have worked on the projects meant for the betterment women's condition and have continued an effective program to protect the basic women's rights and it is expanding with time.

Our Organisation have conducted several surveys to analyze the real reasons behind negligence of women's basic rights and arranged the dialogue of personalities working on human rights and in results the suggestions are obtained from them. The basic problem is illiteracy because illiterate women don't know about their basic human rights. Beside spreading awareness about women's right among female students our Organisation have also discussed it with the teachers also for better outcomes. It is inevitable to stop this discrimination towards women in order to progress and prosper.





PROBLEMS OF WORKING WOMEN:

Though, women of all classes are the victims of discrimination but according to the survey of Care Plus welfare Organisation working women or the hard working women mainly face these problems. The goal of our Organisation is to provide the solution to problems of backward and weak classes. Problems of hard working women are given below.

1. Sexually harassing the women workers at work place.
2. Societal discriminative behavior.
3. Negative behavior of male supervisors.
4. Non-permanent employment, feeling of non-safety of employment.
5. Danger of being fired, shameful acts to take advantage from this.
6. Less wages, severe violation of right regarding wages.
7. Physical and mental harassment at public places and on their way to work.
8. Double load.
9. Long working hours/less salary for extra time.
10. To employ favorite people/ took the job of deserving women by making minor excuse.
11. Depriving women's family from social security fund.

SUGGESTIONS

Care Plus welfare Organisation has addressed the issue of women's rights and organized seminars and dialogue programs in order to propose some suggestions and recommendations which are as follow:

1. To create awareness among people about the solving the problems of women. Especially provide training to men and women both.
2. To act upon the laws practically which have been devised for harassment of women at work and public places.
3. Women should have employed on a suitable job according to their ability.
4. To issue the appointment letter to all the working women and provision of service cards.
5. To give them the wages as equal to men because their wages are too low as compare to men.
6. Working women should not allow to work after 7 PM.
7. Separate washrooms should be provided to hard working women on behalf of every factory.



8. It is the responsibility of media to point out the positive sides about the hard working women.
9. The rules and regulation of apology which are pre-determined by the law for women should be practiced fully and to avoid the gender discrimination.
10. To provide the privileges related to pregnancy to the hard working women.
11. To act fully on the provision of rights developed for hard working women and to investigate the law breakers.
12. Non availability of separate wash rooms for women.

The research and survey which has been conducted about the problems and rights of women, by our Organisation have pointed out some individual and group matters which includes:

1. Acid attacks on women.
2. The matter of legal help of women in jail.
3. Incidents of domestic violence on women.
4. Forced marriage incidents.
5. To divorce women after violence.
6. The shameful trend of selling daughters/girls.
7. To not giving the right of vote to the women.
8. To burn the girls for not bringing dowry.
9. To punish women under the irrelevant values like wanni etc.
10. To not to give them their share in property.
11. To not to marry their daughters for the sake of property.

The discrimination towards women and not to give them their rights is a serious issue. Without solving these problems an exemplary society cannot be formed.

Care Plus welfare Organisation have worked immensely on the women rights and gender discrimination. Several seminars, dialogues, walks and group discussions, surveys and researches have been organized and arranged to publish small booklets in order to raise awareness regarding this very important issue.

THE FIELD OF HEALTH AND THE DETAIL OF PLANS THE SERVICES OF Care Plus Welfare Organisation IN THE FIELD OF HEALTH AND THE DETAIL OF PLANS

Now, the population of the country has exceeded to 20 crores but the expansion in health facilities could not bring about to fulfill our needs. If we analyze the available facilities of health and treatment, then we can observe a disappointing condition. Facilities for health and treatment and to practice the hygienic principles are so crucial that no sensible Pakistani can overlook it.

Taking in view the importance of health area, our Organisation has dedicated our services and performed remarkable services in the field of health, however, these services are still not enough and needs more expansion.

THE POSITION OF HEALTH AND TREATMENT IN PAKISTAN

Pakistan is an under developed country where facilities of health are very less with proportion to our population. The people of backward areas are deprived of the facilities of modern hospitals and diagnosis of diseases. If we compare this condition to the developed countries, then we come across to a very disappointing condition. Hospitals with modern facilities are present in big cities but their charges are so high that a lay man cannot think of visiting them. According to the survey of Gallop 1167 hospitals are operational in various areas of Pakistan, according to the numbers of hospitals our country is at 144 among 189 countries. In Pakistan, 0.75 of total GDP has spend in the field of health which is quite low for the population of 20 crores. It is an alarming situation. According to numbers and details of government, 127859 doctors and 1284 medical staff is working in the country. Mostly doctors and medical staff are residing abroad leaving Pakistan behind. At the moment only seventeen thousand Pakistani doctors are serving in USA. Besides that, heavy numbers of Pakistani medical professionals and doctors are working in Europe and in the Middle East. While doctors protest and goes onto the strike every now and then. Private hospitals are also present, but they are operating in the large and wealthy areas of the country.

Care plus welfare Organisation services in the health sector – Pictorial Highlights



This condition of health area is not satisfactory at all. In government hospitals people are not well catered due to the high number of patients. The need of medicines doesn't get fulfill in government hospitals in the tehsil and district level and also in health centers of rural areas because the funds are insufficient that patients cannot be provided with the medicines according to their disease.

The expenses of private clinics and hospitals are so high unbelievably and they are out of reach of lower and middle class. People with very low incomes cannot even think of their treatment get done from a modern hospital having latest facilities related to health.

As far as health policy is concerned, after the eighteenth amendment of the constitution this case has been handed over to the provinces. Now the provinces have prepared the policy according to the needs and situation of the people of their respective province and this has been started from 2010. It was expecting that the situation will get better in the field of health but no prominent conditions have been prevailed after this. Although, changes have been observed but it's too less. The surprising fact is that in the major province of the country no minister for health has been designated for very long time. The death rate from low standard medicines of heart patients and deaths of infants in the absence of oxygen have prevailed the performance of government hospitals. Likewise, in South Punjab's are, Ahmed PurShirqiya an incident took place, in which 200 people burnt in the result of fire incident and lost their lives because no burn units were present nearby and they have faced lot of torture because they had to reach Karachi, Lahore and other big cities for their treatment. Same way, the treatment facilities for hepatitis are not adequate and this disease is spreading fast in the country and its basic reason is nonstandard and polluted water and environment. Diabetes is also very common now and the people affecting by it are also increasing day by day. Solid steps are needed to stay safe from these diseases and for treating them. Government Organisations are continuously serving regarding this but it is not sufficient according to standard and quantity. Non-government Organisations are assisting for the betterment in these areas.

Care Plus Welfare Organisation is fully aware of these facts and figures regarding the facilities and treatment of diseases and it is also working on various health projects and it is trying our best to serve in much better way and our volunteers are working for the betterment of people with passion.



STEPS TAKEN IN THE FIELD OF HEALTH BY CARE PLUS WELFARE ORGANISATION

Our Organisation is fully aware of the situation of health and treatment in the far flung areas. South Punjab is included in that areas of the country where rural areas are lacking the facility of health and some areas like, in Cholistan, people are not provided with the basic health centers by government for even common diseases. Diseases of stomach and blood are very common due to the consumption of nonstandard and polluted underground water, whereas, the disease of liver have captured people in the form of hepatitis. The treatment of hepatitis, especially, Hepatitis C, the treatment is



so costly which cannot be afforded by low income classes. In this scenario our foundation has started working on a plan of hospital for hepatitis in Multan which will be fully equipped with the modern facilities of treatment and have been acquired the land of 16 acres in Multan for this purpose.

Our foundation is struggling hard to save poor people from dangerous and deadly diseases since 2011. It had started with a dispensary, now this development has reached to the establishment of modern hospital for hepatitis after the completing the projects of community development, emergency center and other social activities.

The completion of this hospital for the patients of hepatitis equipped with the modern facilities will prove as a milestone and will be a source of proud for the foundation serving in the field of health.

Establishment of burn units is included in the priorities of Care Plus Welfare Organisation. Presently, burn units are found in very few cities of Pakistan which are quite less according to the required need. Our Organisation has completed survey related to this. After completing the hepatitis hospital Care Plus Welfare Organisation will fully assist in establishing burn units in the government hospitals and also progress towards setting up a separate burn unit as well.

Diabetics is spreading so fast and the reasons are same, unawareness of hygienic practices, poor food quality, and polluted environment etc. this disease is genetic as well as people also become victims individually. Our Organisation have started planning to provide free sugar tests to the patients. We will try to provide free treatment and diagnosis to the patients of diabetes. More attention will be given to the people of distant areas regarding this. Sugar centers will be set up in these areas under our Organisation.

Care Plus Welfare Organisation has started awareness campaign about providing information for hygienic practices and general health. For this purpose, camps have been set up in different areas, where apart from sugar test, provision of free medicines and information to stay safe from this disease have been communicated.

In our society the state of health and security for mother and child health are extremely disappointing and the main reason behind it is the less facilities of health. Care Plus Welfare Organisation is fully aware of this fact and in its health program provision of better health facilities to mother and child health is included. It will be our main aim to set up mother and child health care centers after establishing hepatitis, sugar hospitals and burn units. It is necessary to educate people about that. Awareness centers should be working in community centers and dispensaries regarding this.

Care Plus is a Welfare Organisation and it has organized many free medical and eye camps in the areas where medical facilities are not available and now it has been increasing gradually.



ESTABLISHMENT OF HEPATITIS HOSPITAL IN MULTAN

Hepatitis has spread in Pakistan due to underground polluted and poisonous water and the victims of this deadly disease is increasing day by day. And this situation is quite alarming.

According to a report there are 13 million patients of hepatitis. About four hundred people die just because of hepatitis B&C and this is a very dangerous condition. Pakistan ranked on 2nd number which has the highest number of hepatitis patients.

According to a recent report, about 7.4% of total population of Pakistan is the victim of hepatitis. Patient of hepatitis B&C are included in this. About 5% people of total population are the patients of hepatitis C. People of big and posh areas are also got effected by this disease along with small and distant areas. This disease is spreading in Rawalpindi city and in adjoining areas rapidly and the reason is polluted underground water. The failure of providing clean drinking water to the people is the main cause by which people is becoming victims of hepatitis.

The treatment of hepatitis is costly and a lay man cannot bear its expenses, though the facilities of treating hepatitis is being provided at government level but they are quite insufficient with respect to the number of patients.

People are also not well aware of precautionary measures to stay safe from this disease. Hepatitis C is the most dangerous and the deadly disease. It is difficult to survive from this disease. If it has diagnosed in the early stages then its treatment is quite possible, but due to its costly treatment people of low income are not able to pay for it. Medicines which are provided by the government are too less in quantity that they cannot be distributed to all the patients. Along with government, non-government Organisations also hold a very important role in the treatment of hepatitis patients. Keeping in view this importance Care Plus Welfare Organisation has decided to set up a modern and facilitated hospital for the patients of hepatitis in Multan and now the practical work has been started on this project. When this hospital will be completed, a large number of people suffering with hepatitis would be treated here free of cost.



THE REPORT OF CARE PLUS WELFARE ORGANISATION REGARDING THE SITUATION OF HEPATITIS IN THE COUNTRY

Due to the geographical and climate changes the diseases of hepatitis is spreading in various areas of the country and with the increase in pollution in water the number of patients are increasing day by day. In Sindh and Punjab, the number of hepatitis patients is 39.28 percent. In our country hepatitis A, B, C and D have found. Along with underground polluted water and other reasons, it also caused by the blood transfusion. That's why it is mandatory to test hepatitis while donating blood. Likewise, the worst condition of pipelines is also another cause of spreading disease. According to the result of the survey report of Care Plus Welfare Organisation, it is necessary to provide better facilities for diagnosing and treating hepatitis in the country. It is also of primary importance to aware people about the precautionary measures and the real causes by which they become the victims of this deadly disease. It is the need of time to increase the facilities in government hospitals according to the needs of hepatitis patients.

THE DECISION OF SETTING UP A HEPATITIS HOSPITAL IN MULTAN

Keeping in view the increase in hepatitis patients and unavailability of adequate resources to treat this disease, Care Plus Welfare Organisation has decided to set up a modern facilitated hospital for hepatitis in Multan for which the land has been acquired and construction is in process. Hospital will be situated in the center of the city so it will be easy to access.

FUNDAMENTAL GOALS AND ARRANGEMENTS

Diagnosis of hepatitis by latest technology.

Provision of all necessary machinery and equipment's regarding this so that no one would have to face any sort of difficulty.

The building of hospital is designed in a modern way to provide a better and precautionary measured environment.

Cheap surgeries that can be afforded by poor people.

WHY IT IS NECESSARY TO SET UP A HEPATITIS HOSPITAL

Due to the increase in the hepatitis patients and danger related to the human life by this disease and keeping in view the inadequate facilities regarding this deadly disease, Care Plus Welfare Organisation has decided to set up a hepatitis hospital with modern facilities to the people which are not much fortunate. This hospital is setting up because there are not much facilities in government sector.

Multan is the central city of these backward south Punjab areas, here people can easily access for health facilities. Hospital will be situated at a reachable place without any difficulty.

The establishment of this hospital is taking place due to public need and demand. This hospital will mainly develop for the poor and needy people. A large number of people cannot afford the treatment expenses.

In accordance to our knowledge the hospitals which are capable of providing PCR test facility are Nishtar Hospital, Civil Hospital Multan, Bahawalpur Victoria Hospital Bahawalpur, Sheikh Zaid Hospital Rahim Yar Khan, Civil Hospital Shujabad. District Headquarter Hospital Hafizabad, Holy Family Hospital, Benazir Bhutto Hospital, District Headquarter Hospital Rawalpindi, Allied Hospital Faisalabad, Jinnah Hospital and Institute of Public Health Lahore included. Here only 12 PCR laboratories are present whereas 43 treatment centers are there which are not sufficient.

According to the survey and research conducted by Care Plus Welfare Organisation, about 0.68% of total population of country is suffering from hepatitis and nearly 14 million people get effected by this disease.

COST ON HOSPITAL

Care Plus Hospital would cost 436.900 million Rupees overall and it will provide modern treatment to the patients suffering with hepatitis B, C and D.

A FINE CAMPAIGN AGAINST HEPATITIS

Hepatitis is spreading like a virus and up till now a large number of people have lost their lives due to this disease.



Care Plus Welfare Organisation has taken this crucial step to serve public in the area of health by giving importance to this much attention needed department. After its completion, special attention will be given to the areas where people are effected more by hepatitis by setting up more dispensaries in these areas.

Our Organisation expects full cooperation from fortunate and economically sound personalities. With their interest and patronage this project will get accomplished. After this fully modern hepatitis hospital will comprise of 20 beds will fully help the needy and poor people by providing free diagnostic and treatment facilities.

A think tank will be formed on each level Organisation for research and survey that will present its report to executive council. An election board will also have formed by central Organisation to elect officials

Report of every election process by election board will be submitted to central election board that will announce elected members officially.

ELECTION

Every member of the Organisation will have the right to vote. Voters will select the officials of union council. Officials of different cities and town will elect the tehsil Organisation and tehsil officials will vote for district Organisation. All district officials and members of executive council will select the provincial officials and provincial officials and members of executive council will select the central Organisation.

The selection of officials and members of executive council will be held with the help of secret ballot and election committee of each level will monitor the elections.

TIME PERIOD FOR OFFICIALS

The time duration of officials of each level shall be five years. After every five years election would take place from center to union council level.

ELECTION SCHEDULE

Election committee/board of each level will announce the election schedule which will be as follow:

1. Issuance of list of candidates.
2. Objections regarding lists can be submitted within 3 days of issuance of lists.
3. Objections hearing and decision will be held on the fourth day.
4. Final list of candidates will be released on next day.
5. Last day of nomination papers will be announced, will be received for 3 days.
6. Details of nomination papers will be announced.
7. After the announcement of candidates call of objection will be given for two days.
8. Objections will be submitted followed by nominations.



9. The very next day objections will be heard and decision would be prevailed.
10. Next day the final list of candidates would be released.
11. After five days of releasing final list polling will be held. Election board will announce the place of polling.
12. Polling will be continued from 8AM to 2PM without any break.

After completion of polling votes will be counted in the presence of candidates. After counting results will be announced by the chairman of election board.

In the case of ineffectiveness and separation of any official, in the meeting of other officials and members of executive council will nominate another member of Organisation for the rest of time. Above mentioned procedure will be followed for any vacant seat.

PRISIDENT / CHIEF EXECUTIVE

President will call the meeting of general council and general secretary will inform about it. President will lead the meeting and will be supervisor of all Organisational and other chores.

SENIOR SUB PRESIDENT / SUB PRESIDENTS

In the absence of president senior sub president will call the meeting and preside the meeting. Senior sub presidents which will be 3 in numbers, support president and sub president.

GENERAL SECRETARY

General secretary will take care of all the matters of Organisation. He will develop the report of every meeting. And in every meeting, will seek the validation from members by explaining the last meeting agenda. He will keep all the records safe.

DEPUTY SECRETARY AND JOINT SEXRETARY

They will assist officials and general secretary. Deputy secretary will act as general secretary in his absence.

INFORMATION SECRETARY

Information secretary will inform general council about the meetings and will spread the news about Organisation to the media and will be in contact with the media persons. He will release the press release with the approval of general secretary and president of Organisation's meeting and will present the report about the meeting of general council.



GENERAL COUNCIL

President, senior sub president, sub president, general secretary, deputy general secretary, joint secretary, information secretary, in charge office, finance secretary, audit secretary and seven members of general council, these all will be the members of general council and will take decision on majority basis.

FINANCE SECRETARY

He will prepare all the record of funds and expenditures, and he will acquire approval of all the members of general council in every meeting on financial issues.

METHODE OF ISSUING CHEQUE

Bank Checque will be issue with the signature of president and finance secretary. Donations will be saved in the official account of Organisation. In cash payment, finance secretary and the members of finance committee will issue receipts and the copy of these receipts will be submitted to the audit committee.

AUDIT SECRETARY

The same process will be followed for the selection of audit secretary like other members. He will be bound to develop the audit report. He will be the chairman for the audit committee according to his designation. He will have the authority to ask for the details of accounts of Organisation any time from the finance secretary. And after developing the annual report of the company will make this report accessible to every member of the Organisation.

OFFICE SECRETARY

Office secretary will take care of office material and record and will be responsible for official work. He will monitor the officials and he will be the in charge and supervisor.

THE SUB-COMMITTEES OF CARE PLUS WELFARE ORGANISATION PAKISTAN

The role of sub committees is quite crucial regarding the practical activities. The committees will be formed in the meeting of general council, there will be one chairman and three members of each committee. These committees will be formed on every level from center to union council. In the meeting of general council, chairmen of sub committees will acquire the agreement on presenting their reports. Committees will be bound to work on the approved recommendations by the general council and they will play their best role to accomplish the basic goals of Organisation.



HEALTH COMMITTEE

They will assist in the success of all the projects and plans of Organisation related to health and in other related projects too. The preference will be given to a doctor for the post of chairman of this committee. Health committee will be in contact with volunteers of various hospitals and health centers.

EDUCATIONAL COMMITTEE

This committee will also be formed by general council. It will consist of one chairman and 3 members and Care Plus Welfare Organisation will work for the success of educational plans. This committee will overview the student's educational problems and after recommending a solution to each will problem, it will present its report to the general council of Organisation. In the meeting of general council, these recommendations will take in consideration. After setting up a proper strategy, proper action will be taken regarding these problems.

BASIC HUMAN RIGHTS COMMITTEE

This committee will also be formed by general council. It will consist of one chairman and 3 members. This committee will overview about the situation regarding to the basic human rights and in case of violating these rights and rules, it will present its report to the general council. In the light of this report, general council will develop its strategy to the human rights and hand over it to different committees for implementing. It will overview continuously the situation regarding human rights and will work about it efficiently.

COMMITTEE OF WOMEN WELFARE

This committee will consist of the female members of Organisation; general council will grant its approval. It will work and supervise on the projects related to women welfare, this committee will have the responsibility to develop recommendations about violence against women. It will also organize walks, seminars, talk shows and discussions on the rights of women and to put an end to the violence against women. It will also work to aware women about their rights. It will also observe the problems faced by female students and working ladies.

STUDENTS WELFARE COMMITTEE

It will also be formed by general council and will consist of one chairman and three members. It will visit different schools and colleges to ask the problems faced by students and after completing the survey, it will present its report to general council. This committee will bound to complete the task which will be assign to them by general council.



LITERACY COMMITTEE

It will also have formed by general council and also constitute of one chairman and three members. It will develop its own report other than government report that why the literacy rate is not rising? This committee will also indicate the reasons that why children remain ill literate of school going age? This committee will present its report to the general council meeting.

PUBLICITY COMMITTEE

It will also have formed by general council and also constitute of one chairman and three members. This committee will advertise the welfare programs of the Organisation so that maximum people can take advantage of these programs. It will inform the people about free eye and medical camps so that more people can get benefit from these camps. This committee will aware people about the facilities provided by the government so they can utilize these facilities.

PUBLIC RELATION COMMITTEE

This committee will also be formed by the general council and it will constitute of one chairman and three members. This committee will be in contact with general public and provide awareness about the welfare programs of Organisation among people and will also educate people that how these welfare programs can bring change to their lives.

SURVEY COMMITTEE

This committee will also be formed by the general council and it will constitute of one chairman and two members. This committee will conduct surveys about the acquired facilities of human welfare to the public and it will include those people in the survey who get failed to provide these basic facilities and reasonable and valid needs. It will overview the survey reports of government and different Organisations that they are how close to reality.

EVENS COMMITTEE

This committee will also be formed in the meeting of general council. This committee will be responsible for completion of arrangements of events organized by Organisation and will work upon making events beautiful and successful. This committee will remain in contact with the officials of Organisation regarding the arrangements of different events.

LEGAL AID COMMITTEE

This committee will be comprised of lawyers of Organisation whose approval will be given by general council. The chairman of the committee will be a lawyer and those



people will be included in members who will have the complete knowledge of law. This committee will provide legal help in any legal matter and will guide the officials of Organisation legally.

ADVISORY COMMITTEE

This committee will also be formed by the general council and it will constitute of one chairman and three members. This committee will have discussion on different matters of life with some important personalities related to crucial walks or departments of life. And after developing a report of their suggestion they will present it to council.

MEMBERSHIP SUBSCRIPTION COMMITTEE

This committee will also have formed by general council and it will constitute of one chairman and three members. This will contact with people to subscribe for membership and will present its report to general council and will give its best to make this task of membership subscription successful.

ELECTION COMMITTEE / BOARD

Election committee will be set up on central level which will be established by general council and its decision will be take on majority basis. In case of any draw the chairman's decision will be given priority. Election board will be formed on regional level, comprised of one chairman and three members.

GENERAL COUNCIL

All the officials and officials of general council of Care Plus Welfare Organisation will be its members. It is mandatory for general council to hold three meetings in a year. In every meeting it will be necessary to approve the matters related to general council. If a member of general council will ask for any details related to any member and donation, then the report will be presented to him or her. Discussion will be allowed to all the members of general council on the report.


